## INTRODUCTION

The first edition of the Socio Economic Profile of Delhi was prepared for the year 1998-99 by the Planning Department. Since then, Socio Economic Profile of Delhi for each year is being prepared and released by the Planning Department during the second quarter of the following year.

The main objective of preparation and release of the Socio Economic Profile of Delhi for each year is to make available the latest statistical data relating to major and vital Sectors of the economy and Social Services Sectors to the users at the earliest possible time.

The sectors included in the Socio Economic Profile of Delhi are divided into following three categories:-

- i. Social Sectors
- ii. Infrastructure
- iii. Major Indicators of the economy

Some of the main indicators of Socio-Economic Profile 2007-08 of Delhi are as under:-

- i. The total number of schools in Delhi increased from 4536 in 2003-04 to 5036 in 2007-08. However, the total number of schools of Dte. of Education during this period reduced from 1231 in 2003-04 to 1183 in 2007-08. It reflects the impact of reformative measures initiated by the Dte. of Education in restructuring its schools system by merging the poorly enrolled schools.
- ii. The number of MCD Primary Schools has increased from 1653 in 2003-04 to 1876 in 2007-08.
- iii. The total number of hospitals including Maternity Homes in Delhi has increased from 588 in 2003-04 to 738 in 2007-08 containing 36242 hospital beds as compared to 32188 beds in 2003-04.
- iv. The number of senior citizens benefited with the Old Age Pension Scheme has increased from 1.40 lakh in 2003-04 to 1.85 lakh in 2007-08.
- v. The number of women in distress who were assisted increased from 2842 in 2003-04 to 9138 in 2007-08.

- vi. The number of anganwadis has increased from 3842 in 2003-04 to 6092 in 2007-08.
- vii. The number of unemployed persons registered with the Employment Exchanges in Delhi has decreased from 10.99 lakh in 2003 to 5.57 lakh in 2006.
- viii. The peak demand of electricity has increased from 3626 MW in 2005-06 to 4036 MW in 2007-08.
- ix. The total water supply capacity has increased from 670 MGD in 2003-04 to 740 MGD in 2007-08.
- x. The total number of Factories registered under the Factories Act in Delhi increased from 7013 in 2002-03 to 7914 in 2007-08.
- xi. The total green cover of Delhi has increased from 151 sq.km. in 2001 to 283 sq.km. in 2005.
- xii. The total number of Ration Cards decreased from 38.67 lakh in 2003-04 to 28.04 lakh in 2007-08.
- xiii. The Annual Plan Outlay for Delhi has increased from Rs.5,000 crore in 2004-05 to Rs.10,000 crore in 2008-09.
- xiv. The projected population of Delhi as on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2007 reached to 1.68 crore.
